The Pacific Northwest Artists Archive Advisory Group oversees the development of the Archive while considering the following criteria:

- is, or was, the artist active in Oregon or Washington for the major portion of his or her career;
- does the collection serve as a complement to the artist's works which are a part of the Hallie Ford Museum of Art's permanent collection;
- will the collection support the Willamette faculty in their teaching and bolster the curriculum;
- can the collection be used to promote and foster original research among Willamette's undergraduate students, Willamette faculty members, and scholars from beyond the University;
- does Willamette have the necessary resources to be responsible stewards of the collection long-term.

The Advisory Group is composed of members from Willamette University's Mark O. Hatfield Library, the Hallie Ford Museum of Art (HFMA), and faculty and students from the College of Liberal Arts. The group was formed in July 2013.
